
## Notes:

4.	What might Isaac's perception of this sacrifice be? Would his perception be the same as Abraham's? When might your son's perception of your obedience to God differ from your perception?
5.	Child sacrifice was common not only around Israel, but sometimes within Israel. What does Genesis 22 reveal about God, Abraham and child-sacrifice?
